IgniteMOBILE has many goals but its primary mission is to support and encourage new ministries and businesses in the Mobile area. IgniteMOBILE does this by using its nonprofit status as a parent company which allows other ministries or businesses to use this tax code to apply for grants and function as a full nonprofit. As your ministry or business grows to a desired size, these entities may branch off under their own nonprofit status.

Questions you may ask:

What is a nonprofit incubator? A nonprofit incubator is an organization that helps to nurture and facilitate the development of a young nonprofit through the provision of resources, services, and seed funding (toward audits). The use of an incubator improves the chances that a new organization will be able to remain sustainable over time, and also provides strong opportunities to build relationships with other organizations in the sector.

What benefits can nonprofit incubators offer? Here are some of the primary benefits that can be reaped from the use of an incubator:

Networking opportunities: Becoming an incubated nonprofit comes with a chance to work among other incubated nonprofits. By developing bonds with other new nonprofits in the field, there are opportunities to share ideas and create alliances with these groups, which will in turn build the strength of your own organization. By receiving this extra guidance and mentorship, new nonprofits can get a leg up over other organizations whose work may be stalled by common beginner's mistakes, and can make major strides toward becoming mature, independent organizations in the future.

What is the investment cost? IgniteMOBILE requires all incubated nonprofits to pay 5% of its deposited income to pay toward the membership cost. This includes the administrative, management and audit cost. Last we ask for the incubated organization to serve in two positions (a voting and non voting member of IgniteMOBILE.)
