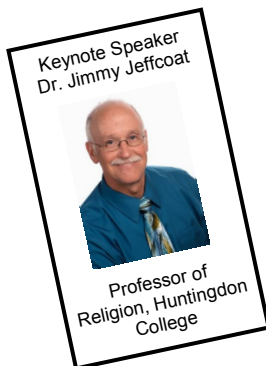

DIRECTIONS TO BLUE LAKE

Interstate 65 North from Mobile

Exit 93 at Evergreen on US 84. Continue to US 29 in Andalusia. Go south on US 29 to AL 137. Turn left on 137. Watch for *Blue Lake United Methodist Assembly* sign at the 9-mile marker on AL 137.

Interstate 65 South from Montgomery

Exit 114 at Georgiana on AL 55. At River Fall, turn left onto US 84. In Andalusia turn right (south) on US 29 to AL 137. Turn left on 137. Watch for *Blue Lake United Methodist Assembly* sign at the 9-mile marker on AL 137.

Interstate 10 East from Mobile/Pensacola

Exit 45 at Holt. Go left (north) to US 90. Turn right on US 90, go 1 1/2 miles and turn left on FL 189 at "To Baker" sign. Cross railroad tracks. Go 5 miles and turn left (north) on FL 4/189 at Ritz Chevron store. Go through Baker to AL 137. Watch for *Blue Lake United Methodist Assembly* sign at the 9-mile marker on AL 137.
